

ACCA Diploma in Financial and Management Accounting (RQF Level 2)

Objectives: Foundations in Accountancy (FIA) is a suite of awards that employers can use to provide employees with a grounding in accounting and finance. The qualifications can be used to develop recruits from secondary schools or to encourage those already working in accounts support roles to obtain formal recognition of their abilities. This program is to prepare candidates who wish to be awarded the ACCA Diploma in Financial and Management Accounting (RQF Level 2) to pass both the FA1 and MA1 examinations and successfully complete the Foundations in Professionalism module.

Pre-requisites:

- Age: 18 years old and above.
- Academic Requirement: No formal entry requirements
- Language Proficiency: IELTS 5.5 and above; or at least C6 in 'O' level English; or pass SCI placement test.

Course Completion & Certification:

- Attendance must not be less than 75% and not absent for more than 7 days in a row.
- Upon completion and passing the examination of FA1 Recording Financial Transactions and MA1 Management Information, with the completion of FIP foundation in Professionalism, students will be awarded with the **Diploma in Financial and Management Accounting** by ACCA.

Mode of Assessment:

- Internal Assessment: Placement test, end-of-course examinations, homework assignments.
- External Assessment: FA1 Recording Financial Transactions and MA1 Management Information, with the completion of FIP foundation in Professionalism (Log on to for more information; <https://www.accaglobal.com/ca/en/qualifications/glance/foundation-level/course-details.html>)
